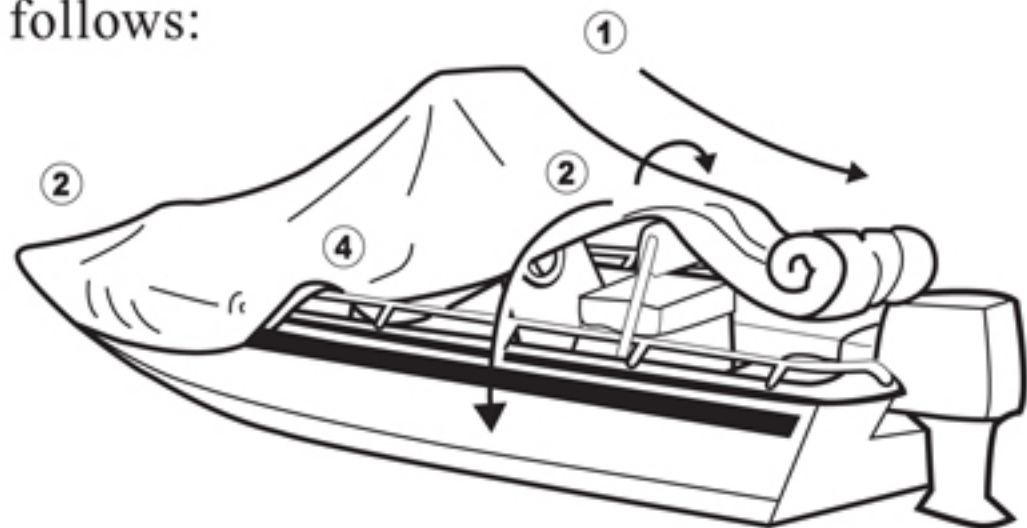


BOAT COVER

User's Manual

The tag on the bow end is sewn into the inside hem of the cover. To cover your boat, proceed as follows:



1. Place the bow end of the rolled cover on or near the bow of your boat and unroll towards the stern or back, positioning it down the center of the boat as you unroll.
2. Slip the front of the cover over the bow and pull the cover open to the sides as you work towards the back of the boat.
3. If using support poles (optional for most covers), position the poles under your cover prior to completely covering the boat. Also add any padding needed for the windshields, trolling motors, depth finders, etc.
4. Adjust cover fit by pulling cover tight to eliminate sagging areas. These areas may collect standing water or snow and shorten the life of your cover.
5. Thread the tie down straps on to the top and bottom tie down clips. Pull the top strap over the top of the boat and the bottom strap under the boat. Secure clips and cinch tight.(figure 2.)
6. Remove the boat cover by folding to the center from both sides and rolling the cover from back to front. This will make it easier to repeat steps 1 thru 5 when covering your boat again. (Important: Allow the cover to dry thoroughly before folding for storage.)

Care and Maintenance

Avoid letting water or snow stand on the boat cover - use support poles, straps, or bows.

Always tie boat cover down securely.

Take the precaution of padding windshield, trolling motors, depth finders, etc. before installing boat cover.

Allow boat cover to dry thoroughly before folding for storage.

Limited Warranty

The materials and workmanship are guaranteed to be free of defects at time of manufacture. The warranty does not cover normal wear, weather soiling, or stains from environmental pollution. The boat cover must be properly installed, utilized and maintained.

If there is a defect, the maker will repair or replace (at its discretion) the boat cover free of charge provided the customer prepays freight to and from the factory.

The warranty is for a period of one full year dated from original purchase date. The warranty is in lieu of all other warranties, express or implied.

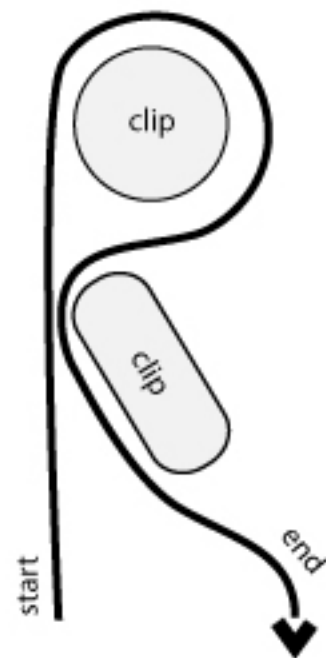
Cover Color

All covers are treated for UV protection. Covers will fade at different rates due to exposure time in the sun. The color fading does not affect the materials or durability of the cover. Fading material is not covered under the warranty.



Proper Strap Threading

(plastic clip - side view)



Note:

When strap is cinched it should stay tight. If the strap does not stay tight remove the plastic clip, flip 180 degrees and cinch tight.
