

# A Safe And Versatile Loading Solution For Motorcycles

The best-selling Big Boy motorcycle loading ramp has been redesigned and taken to the next level, making it even more versatile. Made from aircraft-grade aluminum, the Big Boy II two-piece motorcycle ramp system is 10 feet long and 38 inches wide. For convenience and flexibility of use, it features a pair of 19-inch-wide folding sections that lock together, giving you 38 inches of loading surface. Securing the two ramps together is accomplished with a set of four quick-connect support brackets. At the same time, the brackets eliminate ramp flex and allow the ramp to be split in two sections by pulling a spring clip pin. The extra-long 10-foot length, combined with the 12-degree offset in the hinge, acts the same as an arched ramp and provides additional ground clearance to eliminate bottoming when loading into 4x4 pick-up trucks or loading lowered bikes. The Big Boy II ramp allows one person to drive the motorcycle up the ramp or you can walk up one runner while pushing the bike up the other.

The system features a 4-inch solid full attaching lip that distributes the weight evenly across your tailgate to eliminate any damage to the vehicle. At the bottom of the ramp, the tapered foot has an extruded traction surface that creates a smooth loading approach surface at almost any angle. This extruded foot has a built-in radius on the bottom that will pivot on different vehicle load heights. The Big Boy II ramp comes with two heavy cam buckle safety straps that connect it to the vehicle to keep it from kicking out while loading. The serrated cross rung loading surface are spaced 3 5/8 inches apart so your foot will not slide



through while walking on the ramp's surface...very important.

The Big Boy II ramp system allows a single person to easily load cruisers, sport-bikes, touring motorcycles and other types of motorcycles onto a pick-up or trailer safely. It can also load ATVs, UTVs and tractors. The ramps fold to fit into most pick-up truck cabs or next to the bike in the truck bed. The two-ramp system is rated at 2,500 pounds, and once folded it is 60.5 inches long and 7.5 inches high.
