

Leash Instructions



Step One: Slide the adjustable clips onto the leg loops.

Step Two: Roll the padded sleeves around the leg loops with the rubber side facing inwards.

Step Three: Put the leash on the dog and adjust the clips (if needed). Your dog will likely prefer a nice loose fit. Many owners of our leash have actually told us that they do not use the clips. It is up to you – see what works best with your pet.

Instructions

The Bottom's Up Leash is extremely easy to put on and take off. The leg loops are not meant to fit snug around the legs. There should be a gap over the animal's back where the loops and handle strap meet and this was designed with the dogs comfort in mind.

Step One: Take one of the leg loops and slide it under one of your animals rear legs. Slide it up so that it fits into the groin area. Do the same with the other leg. **The loops that fit around the dogs legs are not supposed to fit snugly around your pets legs. A nice loose fit ensures the comfort of your pet.** When properly on, the two loops and handle will meet above the back of the animal somewhat in line with the hips of the dog.

Step Two: Adjust the handle to the desired length. The handle is the loop with the black plastic adjustable snap-lock. Adjust the handle to whatever length is most comfortable for you to hold.

Step Three: When the leash is in position for the first-time let the animal just stand up and get used to it. It might take some time but the animal will eventually get used to it. A front leash may also be used. Some animals still need guidance (see Diagram 2).
