



## Roof Bike Rack

### Instructions for Part #BC-TL-501

## General Guidelines

- It is the user's responsibility to read and follow all instructions.
- Keep these instructions with the product at all times and review before each use.
- It is the responsibility of this product's owner to furnish the instructions to any person that borrows or purchases the product.
- Inspect the product before use to ensure it is assembled properly and all parts are in safe working order and free of defects.
- Never modify this product in any way.
- All circumstances cannot be addressed in these instructions. Please use common sense and practice general safety measures when using this product.
- Parts and/or instructions are subject to change without notice.

## Safety

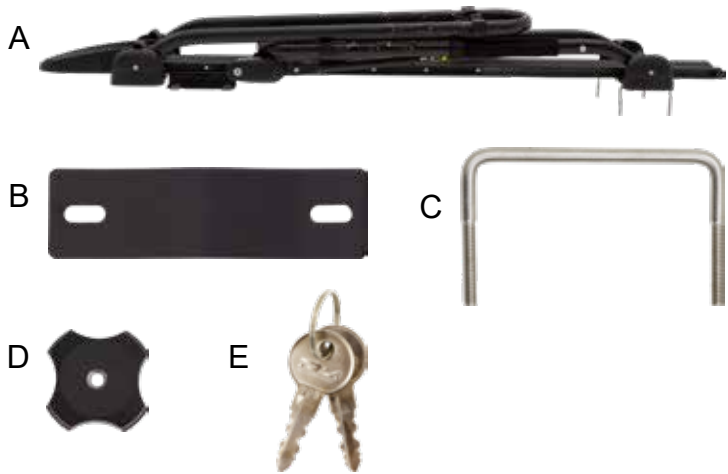
- Never exceed the 44 lb weight capacity.
- Not for use with bikes with fenders or tire guards.
- Always make sure the capacity of your vehicle roof and crossbars can sustain the weight of the bike carrier and bike.
- Make sure you have adequate room to install the bike rack and bike. A step stool or tire step (sold separately) may be necessary to safely install and load the rack.
- The distance between the bike rack and vehicle roof should be at least 1.75".
- Make sure the bike rack is balanced with any other cargo on your roof for a balanced load.
- Be sure to allow enough room for your bike when using with other roof cargo.
- Always lock the bike rack when in use.
- Remove the bike rack before going through a car wash.
- Periodically recheck the bike and bike rack during travel, especially during bad weather, heavy traffic, or when driving at high speeds.
- Avoid excessive speed, sharp turns, and sudden braking when the rack is installed.
- Always follow local traffic rules.
- Failure to follow these instructions can lead to serious injury and property damage.

## Maintenance

The bike rack may be cleaned using a clean, damp cloth and water. Allow the rack to thoroughly dry in a cool, dry place.

Do NOT use thinner to clean the rack. Do NOT oil the hardware.

A	Main Body of Bike Rack*	1
B	Bracket Plate	4
C	U-Bolt	2
D	Turn Knob	8
E	Key Set	1

\*Lock mechanism may be facing either right or left depending on model.

# Installation

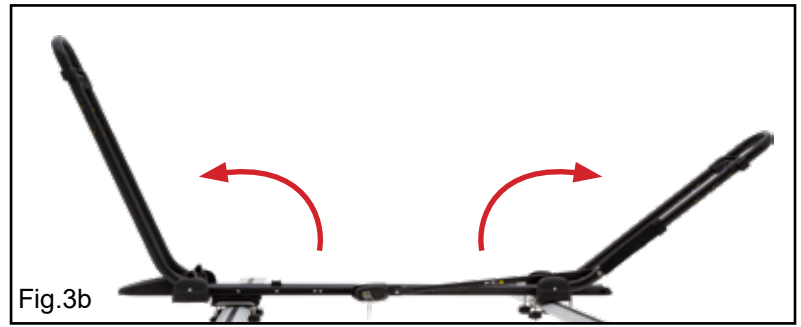
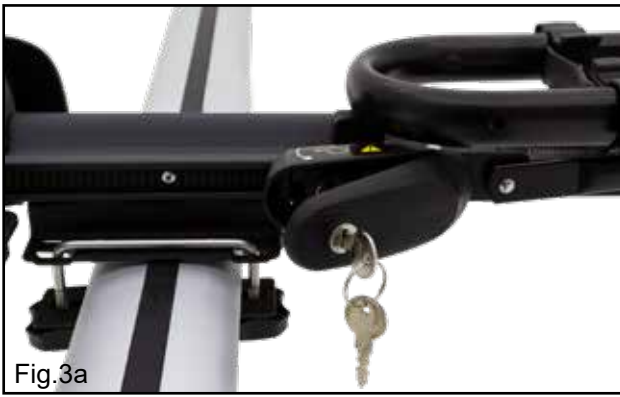
**Step 1.** Insert the two U-bolts into the front mounting bracket on the main body of the bike rack. Place the rack onto the vehicle crossbars, fitting the U-bolts around each crossbar. The front mounting bracket can slide to adjust to the appropriate distance needed.



**Step 2.** Secure all U-bolts tightly with the turn knobs.

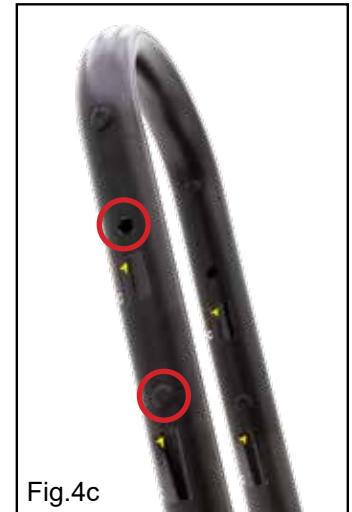
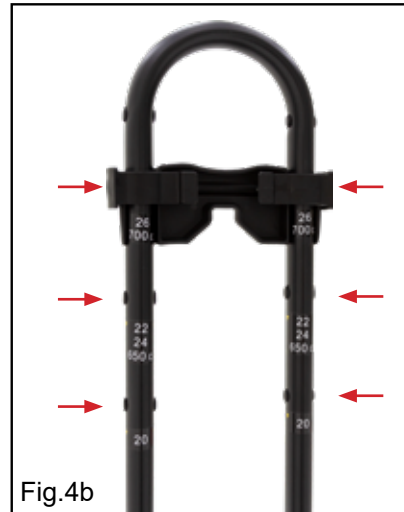


**Step 3.** Extend the bike rack front arm, then unlock the rear arm to release it and extend it back.



**Step 4.** Adjust or remove the tire adapters as necessary.

For 29" bike tires, remove the adapters: Pull the adapter pins outwards to remove, then remove each adapter off the arm. For smaller bike tires, note the sizes indicated on the bike rack for appropriate placement. Adjust the rubber plugs on the arm to allow a different placement of the adapter.



**Step 5.** Carefully place the bike into the bike rack tray, fitting the tires into each arm. Adjust arms as needed, making sure the tires are securely held in place. Lock the rear arm in place.



# Product Warranty and Liability

**GENERAL PRODUCT WARRANTY:** Products purchased from the Authorized Dealer (original place of purchase) or Merchant (“Dealer”) will be free of defects in material and workmanship at the time of receipt, and will meet the specifications stated at the place of purchase transaction or online at the Dealer’s website, under normal use and service when correctly installed, operated and maintained. This limited warranty does not cover products purchased through non-authorized dealers. Non-authorized dealer receipts are not accepted for warranty verification.

**WARRANTY PERIOD:** This warranty remains in force for one year from the date of the product’s accepted delivery. The Authorized Dealer offers a one year manufacturer’s warranty for most products unless otherwise specified on the product advertisement.

**WARRANTY SERVICE:** The Authorized Dealer will replace any defective or malfunctioning part at no charge, including payment of the shipping costs of parts or replacement product to and from the manufacturer. The purchaser is responsible for labor charges. If the product does not meet specifications as depicted in the advertisement, the Authorized Dealer will refund the full purchase price of the product.

Questions regarding the warranty on a specific product and warranty claims should be directed to the Authorized Dealer with whom the purchase transaction was made.

**WARRANTY LIMITATIONS:** The above warranty does not apply to products that are repaired, modified or altered by any party other than the Authorized Dealer; are subjected to unusual physical stress or conditions (such as overloaded ramps or corrosion), natural disaster, governmental actions, wars, strikes, labor disputes, riots, theft, vandalism, terrorism or any reason beyond reasonable control; are damaged due to improper installation, misuse, abuse, accident or negligence in use, storage, transportation or handling, or tampering; or to products that are considered consumable items or items requiring repair or replacement due to normal wear and tear.

Product should be inspected prior to signing for delivery. Product damage incurred during shipping, unless noted on the Bill of Lading at the time of delivery, renders this warranty void.

**LIMITED LIABILITY:** In no event shall THE AUTHORIZED DEALER be liable to the purchaser or any third party for any indirect, incidental, consequential, special, exemplary or punitive damages arising out of the use of the product, including, without limitation, property damage, loss of value of the product or any third party products that are used in or with the product, or loss of use of the product or any third party products that are used in or with the product.
