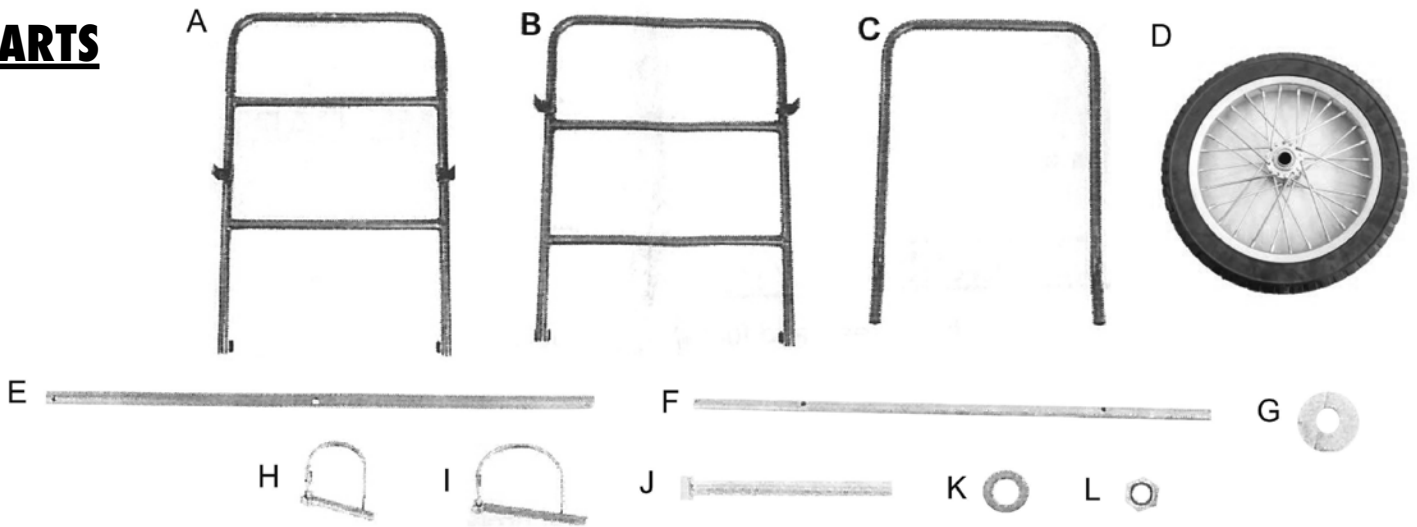

ASSEMBLY

Step 1. Align the top frame (A) and bottom frame (B). Insert the axle (F) through the brackets to connect the two pieces.

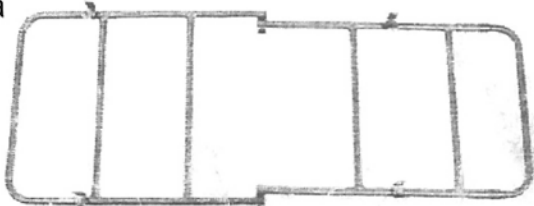
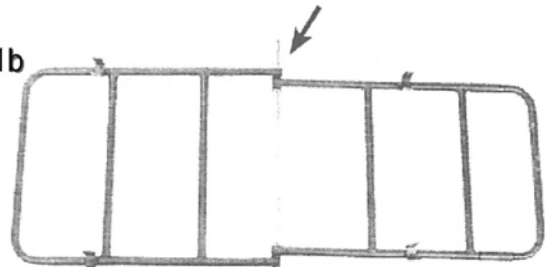

Step 2. Connect the support arms (E) to the frame. Place the support arm into the brackets on the bottom frame (B) and top frame (A). Secure in place with large spring pins (I). Repeat for the other support arm.

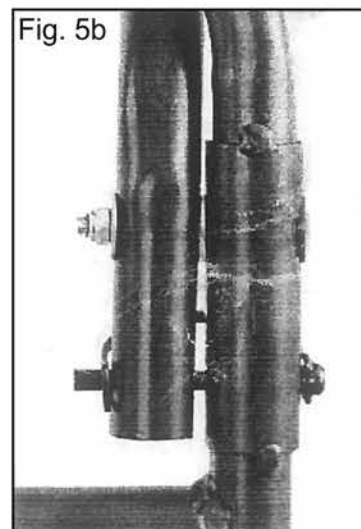
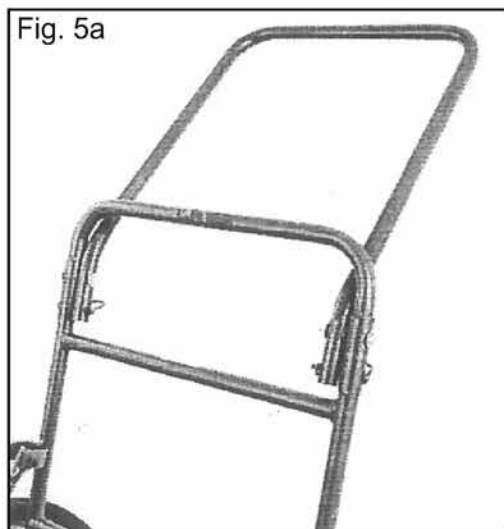
Step 3. Secure the axle (F) in place using two small spring pins (H). Insert each pin into the holes on the axle on the inside of the frame.



Step 4. Connect the wheels (D) to the axle (F). Place a washer (G) on the axle. Then, place the wheel onto the axle. Place a second washer (G) onto the axle, then secure in place using a small spring pin (H).



Step 5. Attach the handle (C) to the top frame (A) using the 10mm bolts (J), washers (K), and nuts (L) and two large spring pins (I).



Folding Up the Cart

Step 1. Remove the large spring pins from the support arms. Reattach each support arm to the brackets on the upper frame using the center hole on the support arm and securing with a spring pin. Attach the remaining two spring pins to the brackets on the lower frame.

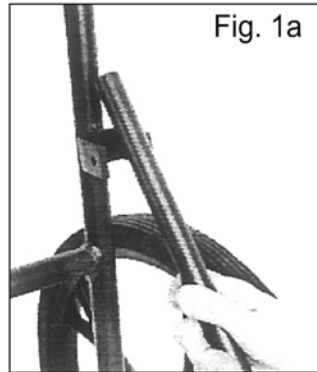

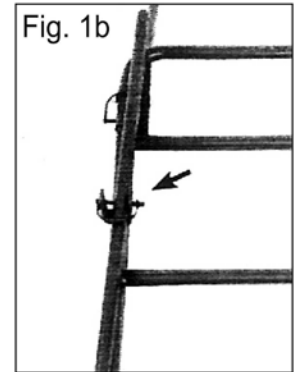

Step 2. Remove the small spring pin and washers from each axle end. Remove the wheels. Place the removed washers and spring pin back on the axle and secure.

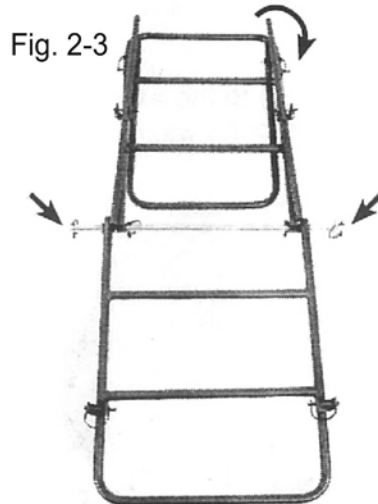

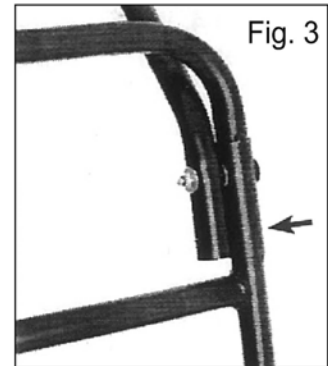

Step 3. Remove the spring pins from the handle and fold the handle down. Replace the pins into the holes on the top frame only.

Step 4. Fold the upper and lower frame assemblies together, in the reverse direction of the open position. The handle will now be between the upper and lower frame assemblies. The cart will be compact.

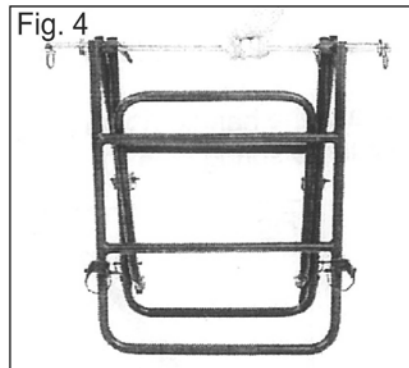

Step 5. Lay the cart flat on the ground. Attach one wheel to one side of the folded cart using the provided buckle straps. To assure the cart will stay in the folded position, run each buckle strap through both frames and the wheel. Flip the cart over and secure the other wheel in the same manner. Pick up the cart and make sure the straps keep the cart from shifting out of the folding position. Your cart is now ready for transport.

PRODUCT WARRANTY & LIABILITY
