YARDRAMP OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Back up the tractor trailer and center within a few feet of the upper end of the yardramp.
2. Using the integral Hand Crank, crank the upper Lip of the yardramp so it is several inches higher than the floor of the trailer.
3. Attach the provided Ramp Clamp to the low end of the yardramp and move the forklift so one of the forks passes through the Ramp Clamp. Then tighten the Ramp Clamp screw against the fork.
4. Using the forklift, raise the lower end of the yardramp slightly and move the Lip of the yardramp into the trailer until it abuts the trailer.
5. Using the forklift, lower the yardramp to the ground and reverse the operation described in step 3.
6. Using the Hand Crank, crank the upper Lip down onto the floor of the trailer until the yardramp wheels are several inches above the ground.
7. Using the attached safety chains, wrap the two chains around the ICC Bumper of the trailer and secure using the hook end of the chain. The yardramp is now ready for use.
8. When finished, remove the safety chains from the trailer and raise the yardramp several inches above the trailer. The trailer can now depart.
