

Steel Stationary Yard Ramp

Instructions for Part # RYR-30 Series



General Guidelines ⚠️

- It is the user's responsibility to read and follow all instructions.
- Keep these instructions with the product at all times and review before each use.
- It is the responsibility of this product's owner to furnish the instructions to any person that borrows or purchases the product.
- Inspect the product before use to ensure it is assembled properly and all parts are in safe working order and free of defects.
- Never modify this product in any way.

Safety ⚠️

- When in use, connect the safety chains of the yard ramp to wedge anchors on the loading dock.
- Avoid sudden stops in transit.
- When positioning the ramp and loading the ramp, do not exceed 3 mph.
- Check the tires for loose lug nuts and worn bearings monthly.
- Always chock wheels when using the yard ramp.
- Do not exceed the weight capacity listed on the product.
- This yard ramp is designed to accommodate 40" - 52" H loading docks.

Unloading a Yard Ramp from a Flat Bed Truck

To remove a yard ramp from a flat bed truck, two forklifts are required. Position the forklifts directly across from each other, one on either side of the yard ramp. Slowly and carefully raise the forks of each lift at the same time, evenly raising the yard ramp above the truck bed.

When adequate clearance is achieved, pull the flat bed truck forward, allowing room to lower the yard ramp onto the ground.

Once on the ground, the yard ramp can be moved using one forklift as outlined below.



Usage Instructions - Caution: Important Information!

Moving the Yard Ramp

1. Securely install the tow bar on the foot of the yard ramp, bolting it into place.
2. Slide the forklift forks into the tow bar. Raise the ramp so the end of the ramp is off the ground and slowly move the ramp to the desired location.
3. When moving the yard ramp, the maximum recommended speed is 5 mph.



Positioning for Use

1. Position the yard ramp directly in front of the loading dock.
2. From inside the loading dock, use an appropriate forklift and forklift sling to raise the ramp end onto the edge of the loading dock. The lip of the yard ramp must rest entirely on the loading dock.
3. Connect the yard ramp safety chains to wedge anchors on the loading dock. The safety chains should be anchored to the face of the dock approximately two feet on either side of the yard ramp and approximately one foot down from the top of the dock. **WARNING:** Leave three chain links slack in the safety chains. DO NOT attach too tightly.
4. After the yard ramp is properly positioned, remove the tow bar before use.

Removing from the "In Use" Position

1. Disconnect the safety chains.
2. Raise the ramp off the loading dock using a forklift and forklift sling and set the ramp down so the wheels are on the ground.
3. Move the yard ramp as described in the steps above.

Product Warranty and Liability

WARRANTY PERIOD: This warranty remains in force for one year from the date of the product's accepted delivery. The Authorized Dealer offers a one year manufacturer's warranty for most products unless otherwise specified on the product advertisement.

WARRANTY SERVICE: The Authorized Dealer will replace any defective or malfunctioning part at no charge, including payment of the shipping costs of parts or replacement product to and from the manufacturer. The purchaser is responsible for labor charges. If the product does not meet specifications as depicted in the advertisement, the Authorized Dealer will refund the full purchase price of the product.

Questions regarding the warranty on a specific product and warranty claims should be directed to the Authorized Dealer with whom the purchase transaction was made.
