

# Portable Steel Yard Ramp

## Instructions for Part # RYR-44-25



### General Guidelines ⚠️

- It is the user's responsibility to read and follow all instructions.
- Keep these instructions with the product at all times and review before each use.
- It is the responsibility of this product's owner to furnish the instructions to any person that borrows or purchases the product.
- Inspect the product before use to ensure it is assembled properly and all parts are in safe working order and free of defects.
- Never modify this product in any way.

### Safety ⚠️

- When in use, connect the safety chains of the yard ramp to the trailer.
- Avoid sudden stops in transit.
- When positioning the ramp and loading the ramp, do not exceed 3 mph.
- Check the tires for loose lug nuts and worn bearings monthly.
- Always chock wheels when using the yard ramp.
- Do not exceed the 25,000 lb weight capacity.

### Unloading a Yard Ramp from a Flat Bed Truck

To remove a yard ramp from a flat bed truck, two forklifts are required. Position the forklifts directly across from each other, one on either side of the yard ramp. Slowly and carefully raise the forks of each lift at the same time, evenly raising the yard ramp above the truck bed.

When adequate clearance is achieved, pull the flat bed truck forward, allowing room to lower the yard ramp onto the ground.

Once on the ground, the yard ramp can be moved using one forklift as outlined below.



# Usage Instructions - Caution: Important Information!

## **Moving the Yard Ramp**

1. Raise the approach ramps to a resting position on the yard ramp.
2. Raise the ramp legs into the compact position by using the crank handle located near the legs.
3. Slide the forklift forks into the base plate cutouts. Raise the ramp so the end of the ramp is off the ground and slowly move the ramp to the desired location. **DO NOT use the pockets on the lead up ramps to move the yard ramp.**
4. When moving the yard ramp, the maximum recommended speed is 5 mph.

## **Positioning for Use**

1. Using the crank handle, raise the ramp to 2" higher than the vehicle height or dock floor.
2. Move the ramp into position so the apron overlaps the floor on the vehicle/dock when folded down. Do not back the vehicle up to the ramp. This can cause damage and unsafe loading conditions.
3. Lower the legs to the needed height with the crank handle to allow for needed support. **NEVER USE THE RAMP WITHOUT THE SUPPORT LEGS IN PLACE. THIS IS DANGEROUS AND CAN CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.**
4. If your trailer is equipped with air bag suspension, release air before loading.
5. Secure the ramp to the trailer or dock with the attached safety chains. **WARNING:** Leave three chain links slack in the safety chains. **DO NOT** attach too tightly.

## **Removing from the "In Use" Position**

1. Disconnect the safety chains.
2. Raise the ramp apron above the vehicle floor level.
3. Roll the ramp away from the vehicle.

## Product Warranty and Liability

**WARRANTY PERIOD:** This warranty remains in force for one year from the date of the product's accepted delivery. The Authorized Dealer offers a one year manufacturer's warranty for most products unless otherwise specified on the product advertisement.

**WARRANTY SERVICE:** The Authorized Dealer will replace any defective or malfunctioning part at no charge, including payment of the shipping costs of parts or replacement product to and from the manufacturer. The purchaser is responsible for labor charges. If the product does not meet specifications as depicted in the advertisement, the Authorized Dealer will refund the full purchase price of the product.

Questions regarding the warranty on a specific product and warranty claims should be directed to the Authorized Dealer with whom the purchase transaction was made.

**WARRANTY LIMITATIONS:** The above warranty does not apply to products that are repaired, modified or altered by any party other than the Authorized Dealer; are subjected to unusual physical stress or conditions (such as overloaded ramps or corrosion), natural disaster, governmental actions, wars, strikes, labor disputes, riots, theft, vandalism, terrorism or any reason beyond reasonable control; are damaged due to improper installation, misuse, abuse, accident or negligence in use, storage, transportation or handling, or tampering; or to products that are considered consumable items or items requiring repair or replacement due to normal wear and tear.

Product should be inspected prior to signing for delivery. Product damage incurred during shipping, unless noted on the Bill of Lading at the time of delivery, renders this warranty void.
